THE SCHOOL...

TCMS will provide a challenging academic program in core areas and will provide an exploratory schedule so that students may "try on" different elective areas to round out and enhance their education. TCMS will also provide a variety of extracurricular activities to meet a variety of interests and promote them to students.

TCMS will at all times encourage wellness and a healthy lifestyle for students.

TCMS will provide positive role models for students. Additionally, positive social skills will be taught and used in the Instructional Discipline model.

TCMS will provide a 3-week extended school year for those students who need the "gift of time" to complete the school year.

TCMS will provide a 3-week extended school year for returning middle school students who want to participate in "Cool School". The opportunity will also be extended to incoming 6th graders.

TCMS values the family and will communicate with the family and provide information pertinent to the student's educational progress.

TCMS will provide incentive programs to promote and encourage attendance, academics, and self-esteem.

TCMS will provide before and after school tutoring for students who express that need or desire. Home Study is an alternative for students assigned to it.

THE HOME...

FAMILIES will make the commitment to send their children to school appropriately dressed, prepared to learn, with needed school supplies, and on time.

FAMILIES will support their students by reading the school handbook and policies and stressing their importance.

FAMILIES will promote their students' academic success by becoming resource people for classes, assisting their students with homework, and/or attending two or more family or team conferences a year to discuss their student's educational progress.

FAMILIES will work with the schools to promote positive role models for their students and help to instill a positive attitude about education.

FAMILIES will work with the school to promote, encourage, and support their students in extra-curricular activities; for example: sports, drama, music, intramurals, Technology Fair, Science Fair, etc.
