Habitat

Sea stars live in Muddy Places, coral reefs, and shallow water. Most seastars spend most of their adult lives resting on the ocean floor.

Food

Most seastars do not care for their young. Females just release their eggs into the water. Many females produce millions of eggs at a time.

Facts

Sea stars swallow their prey whole—shells and all. If a sea star gets turned upside down it can turn itself back over by somersaulting. It curls the tips of one or two arms under so its tube feet can grip the bottom. Then it pulls itself over.
