

CONTRACT RENEWAL PROCEDURES WITH ADMINISTRATORS

The Todd County School Board of Education will each year determine whether the contract with each administrator shall be offered for another term. If the board determines to offer a new contract to an administrator, it shall offer the contract in writing by not later than March 15th; and the administrator shall have fifteen (15) days from date of offer to accept, sign and return the contract to the District. If not accepted by that date, the District shall declare the position open and shall commence to seek a replacement for the position.

If the board determines not offer a new contract to an administrator whose contract will expire at the end of the current school year, it will give written notice of that decision to the administrator by not later than March 20th. Such contract shall then expire at the end of its defined term.

The board shall have the authority to determine the rate of pay, hours of employment, fringe benefits, and other conditions of employment that shall be offered as a part of any particular administrator's contract. The board shall not be bound by any terms in one administrator's contract when offering a contract to any other administrator.
