

SCHOOL BOARD NEGOTIATING AGENTS

The board is ultimately responsible for negotiating with employee units. Prior to commencement of any negotiations, the board will decide whether to appoint a labor lawyer, a professional negotiator, or a representative from within the school district to serve as the board's chief negotiator. The balance of the board's negotiating team will be selected by the board.

The fee or salary for a professional negotiator will be established by the board at the time of appointment.

Negotiations will be conducted as directed by the board. No collective bargaining agreement will be effective until the board has reviewed it against existing policies, accepted it, and officially designated its representatives to sign it.
