

ADMISSION OF TRANSFER STUDENTS

Students transferring to Todd County schools from another school district will be permitted to enroll at any time during any semester under the following conditions:

1. there have been no more than five (5) school days between leaving the previous school and enrolling in Todd County schools;
2. the parent or guardian provides proper documentation of enrollment and regular attendance at the previous school;
3. the parent or guardian provides documentation of grades and credits earned at the previous school; this includes transcripts and transfer grades; and
4. the parent or guardian provides documentation of residency in the Todd County School District, legal guardianship by an adult resident of Todd County School District, or acceptance at the Bureau of Indian Affairs Dormitory.

MAKEUP WORK AFTER ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL OR AS A RESULT OF LATE ENROLLMENT

It is, essentially, the student's responsibility to make-up any class work due to absence from school. On the day the student returns to school after an absence, he/she is to contact the teacher(s) to obtain make-up work and assignments for the days absent. This contact can be made during class, before school, or after school.

The student is allowed two (2) days to make-up class work for each one (1) day of absence.

Students will not receive credit for make-up work submitted after the deadline date or credit for make-up work for unexcused absences.

Students enrolling late, in any semester, are responsible for all class work missed due to the late enrollment. This applies to students who enroll at any time after the beginning day of any semester. If a high school student enrolls after classes have begun and/or does not have transfer grades they must make

up all of the missed work by attending the After-School Tutoring program until such time as the work is completed to ensure their success in fulfilling the requirements for each class.
