

## **MINIMUM IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

Student minimum immunization requirements are defined as having received at least:

1. four or more doses of DTP vaccine (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis). At least one dose must have been given on or after age four (4). Children after age seven (7) should receive adult-type Td instead of DTP;
2. three or more doses of trivalent oral polio virus vaccine (TOPV), or enhanced inactivated polio myelitis vaccine (IPV) administered after 1968. At least one dose must have been given on or after age four (4). TOPV can be given until the eighteenth (18th) birthday.
3. Measles-Mumps Rubella Vaccine  
  
two doses of measles virus vaccine administered after the age of twelve (12) months, or having been diagnosed by a physician as having had measles disease;  
  
two doses of rubella virus vaccine administered after the age of twelve (12) months, or having demonstrated serological evidence of rubella antibodies;  
  
two doses of mumps virus vaccine administered after the age of twelve (12) months; and
4. a tuberculin skin test administered prior to first-time entrance to a South Dakota school.
5. a varicella immunization (chicken pox) is required prior to first-time entry into a South Dakota school unless there is proof that the child has already had chicken pox.
